Each donated item will be displayed with the contributing artist's name, business card or Business name, and booth number. Volunteers will be on hand each day to direct interested attendees to your booth in order to see more of your art.

# Winterfest Artisan Market Vendor Rules and Regulations

December 6, 7, 8, 2019

- ❖ All items displayed and sold must be handmade. This is not a venue for resale.
- ❖ All vendors must exhibit and be present during the complete show, 5pm-8pm on Friday, 10am-6pm on Saturday, noon – 5pm on Sunday.
- ❖ Assigned spaces may not be reassigned, conveyed, or transferred in any manner by the artist.
- ❖ Vendor parking will not be permitted in the customer parking.
- ❖ The Booth fee is non-refundable after Nov 1, 2019. Requests for refunds must be made in writing and postmarked prior to Nov 1<sup>st</sup>. Booth fees will not be refunded due to inclement weather, acts of God or other extenuating circumstances.
- ❖ All applications must be postmarked by Nov 19, 2019 or a late fee of \$30 must be added.
- ❖ Notices will be mailed out to applicants that applied prior to Nov 19. If you desire the same space from previous year or if you would like to be located next to a fellow exhibitor, please submit your application early. All requests will be considered as space permits.
- ❖ Booth assignments will be distributed at check-in. Set up time is 2pm-4pm Friday Dec 6.
- ❖ All vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, displays, change, etc, and the legs on everything must have a rubber tip or cushion so the floor is not damaged.
- ❖ Tables must be draped to the floor. A Limited number of 6 foot tables are available for a fee of \$10 each.
- ❖ Electricity is extremely limited. If you have paid for access to electric, you must provide your own 100 ft extension cord and commercial grade surge protector (not household use) . A fire inspection will take place before customers enter on Friday
- ❖ You will be required to display your NC Certificate of Registration (NC Sales tax certificate) conspicuously and prominently all three days
- ❖ Vendors are required to clean up their booth area and leave it free of litter.
- ❖ Vendors violating any of these rules and regulations will not be permitted to exhibit and will be ineligible to participate in future events.

Activities at the indoor 3-day Jacksonville Commons Recreation Center:

Free to attend

We invite the public to participate in several fun contests:

The Chair-ity contest: decorate your chair, complete the entry form, bring your chair, entry form and fee. Price tags may be attached to the chair and the artisan keeps the money from the sale. The Public determines who wins the prize by voting.

The Upcycled Art Contest is very similar in design to the Chair-ity contest and the artist picks up their creations on Sunday evening when the winner is announced for all contests.

The Cookie Contest: complete entry form and drop off cookies, kids will be the judges all weekend long to determine who wins the grocery store gift card.

This event will kick off with a special evening Pre-Sale Party on Friday at the Jacksonville Commons: shop this evening to have the best selection and avoid the rush! Door prizes will be provided by area artists and Santa will be on site.

Saturday Dec 7 from 10am-6pm

Lots to see, shop, and participate in. Shopping in artists and crafters booths. The public votes for the Upcycled Art Contest and The Chair-ity. As for the Cookie Contest – lucky kids are the judges! Door prizes will be awarded all day and food is available on site. Pet Photos with Santa will be available all day.

Sunday Dec 8 from 12pm-5pm

Lots to see, shop, and participate in. Shopping in artists & crafters booths, Upcycled Kids Crafts, and there will be a Gingerbread House Workshop building Gingerbread Houses 2pm-4pm preregistration is required. Winners will be announced for all publicly voted contests.

Jacksonville Transit will provide a FREE shuttle service between Riverwalk Crossing Park and Jacksonville Commons on Saturday, December 7 from 12-7:30PM.

Park at one location and access both the Winterfest outdoor activities at Riverwalk and the Artisan Market at the Commons with the convenience of Jacksonville Transit's shuttle service.
